WHY LIVE PURE?

Ushering into the new millennium, today's society has become more and more tolerant of liberal ideas. Beliefs on sex, relationships, and purity have been gravely distorted by media, creating a consciousness that is, in many ways, void of true Christian value. With the surge of Western ideas permeating our youth pop culture, by way of the digital age, it suddenly became widely accepted among young people to rush into all sorts of intimacy with the opposite sex without having to consider the consequences of their actions. Media has portrayed pre-marital sex as liberating, fulfilling and downright pleasurable. Unknowingly, this mindset debases the true value of sex and promotes a sexually promiscuous lifestyle.

Whether we remain oblivious to the facts or not, values are being corrupted in almost every institution (family, school, friends etc.) we are a part of. The foundations of morality are becoming loose every single day. Statistics will reveal to you staggering rates of teen pregnancies, abortion and sexually transmitted diseases (STDs).

With all these things happening around us, we cannot just sit around and choose to be passive or silent. We cannot lose young people to the false promises of the world. It is our mission to challenge this twisted mindset no matter how daunting the current realities are. We have to make known to everyone God's view and true purpose for love and sexuality.

Pope John Paul II addressed this need during his Wednesday Catecheses in St. Peter's Square between September 5, 1979 and November 28, 1984 and spoke about the human person and human sexuality. John Paul II says that these catecheses could be called "Human Love in the Divine Plan" or "The Redemption of the Body and the Sacramentality of Marriage". In the midst of the profound sexual crisis that is wreaking havoc in both the secular world and in the Church, the

Theology of the Body offers the hope of healing and restoration we all so desperately need, enabling everyone to rediscover not only the meaning of our creation as male and female, but through that, "the meaning of the whole of existence, the meaning of life". In Theology of the Body, John Paul II intends to establish an adequate anthropology in which the human body reveals God. He examines man and woman before the Fall, after it, and at the resurrection of the dead. He also contemplates the sexual complementarity of man and woman. He explores the nature of marriage, celibacy and virginity. The central thesis of John Paul's Theology of the Body is that "the body, and it alone, is capable of making visible what is invisible: the spiritual and the divine. It was created to transfer into the visible reality of the world, the mystery hidden since time immemorial in God, and thus to be a sign of it."

In a world which continues to promote hedonistic lifestyles (promiscuity, drugs etc.) as the answer to man's deepest longings, we are all called to Live Pure – to live a life which embraces chastity as the sure way to happiness. This calling goes beyond our membership to any religious or charismatic community, for it is inherent to us being sons and daughters of God. To live a pure lifestyle is our way to attaining the life God

desires and dreams for us – a life of real freedom, true love and total happiness.

LIVE PURE-LIVING COUNTER-CULTURALLY

It is so easy to go with the tide in the world today, and unfortunately, in the prevailing tide, it is a culture of sexual permissiveness. The young are being massively swept up in it. Propelled by social media and being woke, pressured by the need to conform, lacking parental formation, the youth of today are a lost generation.

But then, there is a reality that gives hope in a seemingly hopeless situation. It is the reality that we are created in God's image and likeness. And much as the world has set God aside, God is still the everpowerful Creator and Almighty. What God wills, God can do. God has had His plan from the very start. We are to live our lives in accordance with His ways, to be a holy people.

And so there is the Live Pure work of MFC, whose members commit to a life of purity. They strive for purity of mind, eyes, speech and body. It is radical in its total commitment of one's whole body to purity and chastity and self-control. Only in such total commitment can one hope to overcome the strong influence of a world steeped in sin, together with the weakness of one's own flesh.

As such, to live pure it is counter cultural. It goes against the grain. It does not give in to basic impulses.

 In a world of widespread pornography, available at the click of a finger, one who lives pure determines to keep his mind free of impure and lustful thoughts. He will not look at pornography. He will avoid all other ways that show explicit sexual content, such as in movies, television, print, pictures.

- In a society where speech is defiled, used to curse, to slander, to lie, to promote sexuallydriven thoughts, to demean the name of the Lord, one who lives pure will only speak with grace. He will use his speech to upbuild, to encourage, to speak truth that sets free, to proclaim the Lord in all His goodness and ways.
- In an environment of permissiveness, where the human body is severely degraded, shorn of all dignity and beauty, the one who lives pure will look on and treat his body as what it truly is, a temple of the Holy Spirit. As such he will not engage in masturbation, fornication or homosexual acts.

One who lives pure desires a clean and whole life free from corruption and compromise. The desire for purity leads one to avoid and resist temptations that would pollute or weaken one's character. As purity is what leads to holiness, to live pure enables you to enter into God's holy presence. As it is said, "Blessed are the clean of heart, for they will see God." (Mt 5:8).

Striving to live pure is counter-cultural. It affects all aspects of one's life. The purity of one's life and heart will be reflected in one's thoughts, words, choices, attitudes, relationships. It will build a world around you that is pleasing to God

This program has the following specific objectives at hand:

- 1.To promote a Live Pure lifestyle among the youth today.
- 2.To bring the cause of Live Pure to Parishes, High Schools, Colleges and Universities through Live Pure formation sessions, workshops and events.

CARING FORTHEYOUNG

Way of Beauty-The program focuses on the beauty of human sexuality based on the Theology of the body and how it can lead a young person to an understanding of self. This understanding leads to a greater conviction to see ourselves as God's masterpiece. Discovering the real meaning of love, relationships and sex inspires young people to make the right choice of striving to live pure. We use creative ways to go through the depths of young people's heart.

Power of Personal Testimony - To be a witness of the joy that comes from choosing chastity is a powerful tool to inspire young people. There is also great power in being vulnerable to young people about our own



challenges in our journey to purity as they see that they are not alone in their journey giving them hope to keep on going

An Encounter with Jesus- this is the ultimate goal in engaging youth at every program, to lead young people to encounter Jesus. The formation focuses on how the lord values us and only by His grace that living a pure lifestyle is possible. With all the brokenness and undertakings that young people go through it is in leading them to Jesus that they discover their way to wholeness.

Spread over 2 days, the program consists of various elements like prayer, sessions, group discussions, activities all focused on helping a youngster understand the truth about their Sexuality and how they can embrace their God given purpose to reflect His love through their life and vocation. The 5 sessions focus on the unique unrepeatability of every individual created in the image and likeness of God, define love, the consequences of lust and a life of impurity and answers common questions a youngster has related to dating, homosexuality, abortion, pornography, pre-marital sex etc. Youth are given practical tips to fight sin and addiction as they are encouraged to rely on the Holy Spirit through channels of Grace. They are exhorted to find freedom in Christ as the program culminates with an encounter with the healing presence of God at the confessional.



LEVEL UP

After two long years, the much awaited Regional Youth Conference, organised by MFC Youth (India), was held between the 23rd to the 25th of October, 2022 at The King's School in Margao, Goa. "Level Up!" was aptly named based on the verse from 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18, which seeks to encourage the youth to live by higher morals of always rejoicing in the Lord, praying without ceasing and giving thanks in all circumstances. The conference had in attendance youth from the South-Western regions of India, namely, Goa, Mumbai, Pune, Mangalore, Bangalore and Chennai.

There was also a talk on Liturgical Bible Study sessions to help youth understand the Sunday liturgy comprehensively. Special sessions were also held for the Youth



Formators to allow for a space of discussion and sharing of their experiences and expectations. This jam-packed day ended with a fun fete night and a Catholic rendition of partying.

The last day of conference didn't see any dullness of spirit. The time of fellowship over the past two days saw a revival of old friendships and the creation of new ones. The highlight of this day was the prayover wherein the community elders prayed over the Formators who then went and prayed over each of their youth. An encouraging message from the Country Servant, Jimmy Xavier, was what everyone needed to retain their new found energy and excitement. With a whole lot of memories, new experiences and renewed spiritual vigour, the conference was brought to a close with the praise fest and the final exhilarating closing act.
